

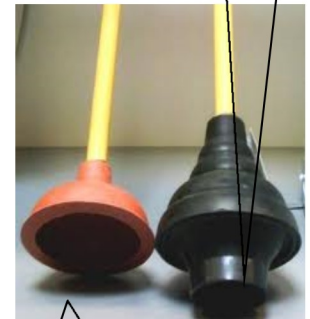
These are in the preferred order before

Remove the lid and observe the internal components. If every thing in the tank has heavy accumulation of sediment like calcium and rust, consider installing all new parts. It will save you a head ach in the long run.

Me for toilet.
 I used to be called a force cup.



Me for sink. Not for nasty water.

Plungers? Of the 2 plungers pictured , the red one is for a flat bottom sink as in the kitchen. The other is for a toilet.

Concept: To force the object through the drain line.

My strategy :

1st Let the clog sit and wait. (unless it leaking ! Turn off water)

9 times out of ten it's to much paper. It will soften up after 20 minutes and the plungers job is easier.

I do not use the plunger as a force ball, but rather a mixture of force and suction. This is done by not pushing the plunger all the way down. Once the plunger is submerged in the muck, I push the plunger down to 75% of it's potential and then bring back up , but not all the way up. Just to the top 25%. Cont. next page
